


Great Lakes Fishery and Ecosystem Restoration Program

- Sediment Remediation






Subsurface Detention examples suggested by Don Webb for parking lot stormwater.



5a. Northville Downs River Park and Daylighting


- Features 12-acre park
- Riverwalk provides connectivity between Foundry Flask,
 Ford Field and Hines Park
- River channel reduces flooding. Able to contain 100year storm.
- Relocation of above-ground sanitary sewer pipe below the streambank.

5b. Research Preservation of Historic Log Cabin

5c. Reduce Downstream Flooding

- Overall site design has significant amount of greenspace.
- Discharge to Johnson Creek and West Branch will be reduced from well over 30 million gallons to estimated 120,000 gallons (assuming annual rainfall of 33")


