#### a. Methodology Overview



## Enrollment Projection Overview (District –Wide)

The following glossary provides a better understanding of the meaning and significance of the enclosed enrollment projection study report.

Plante Moran Cresa uses the standard Cohort Survival Method to project enrollments. The Method uses the historical survival ratios of your pupils from grade to grade to project future enrollment trends. The survival ratio compares the number of pupils in a particular grade last year against the number of pupils in the next advanced grade this year. For example, there were 100 first grade pupils last year and 112 second grade pupils this year; the survival ratio for last year's first grade class is 112%. Enrollment trends are then derived from these statistical data.

When projections are based on Full Time Equivalent (FTE) or Head counts as specified on the upper right of the table, the enrollment projections contain only mainstreamed Pre-kindergarten through 12th grade pupils. Special education pupils are included as general education pupils based on percentage of time spent in the general education classrooms (as Full Time Equivalent). Adult participants and special education pupils are not included in the historical data or projections. Historical pupil enrollment data is obtained from the Michigan Department of Education, Form DS-4061, for FTE, or from head counts provided by your school district.

**County Births:** This line shows the number of resident live births for the past 12 years in the county your school district is located. The live births are used to project by proportion the number of children born in your school district's county who will become pupils in your school district (**K% Birth**). The live births data is obtained from the Michigan Department of Public Health's Office of the State Registrar and Center for Health Statistics. Since the Department of Health cannot reasonably compile all the birth statistics from all counties for a particular year until at the earliest in the fourth quarter of the following year, the current year's number of live birth is therefore estimated.

**Historical Data** columns show past pupil enrollment history in your school district. These columns list pupil enrollments by grade for the past 6 years plus the current year. The percentages under the pupil enrollment numbers are the survival ratios for the respective grades that year. Please be alert for unusual variations in the survival ratios when reviewing these numbers since they are trend indicators for your school district's pupil enrollment.

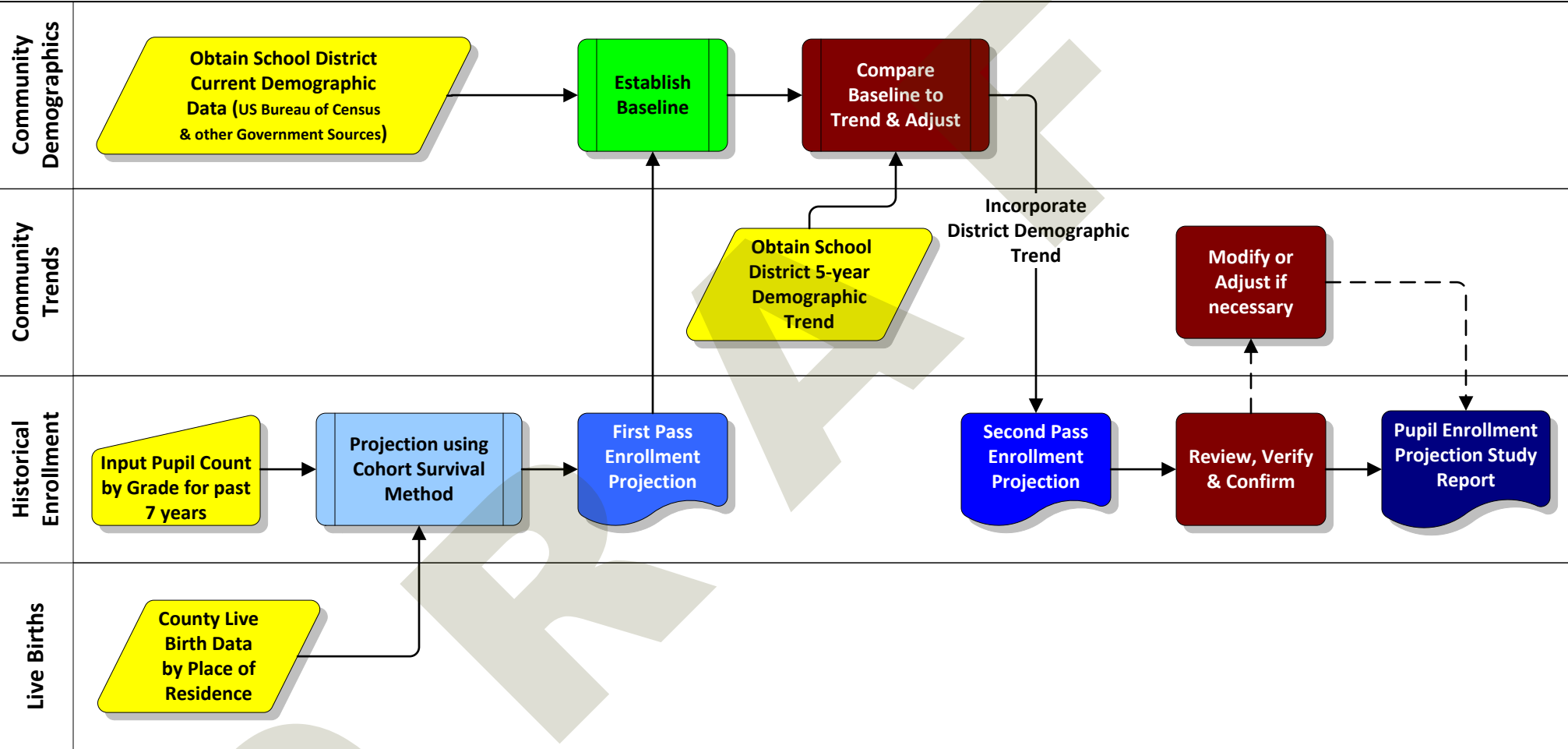
**Projection** applies the survival ratios for the past seven years in a particular grade and extends it out for the next five to ten years. The shaded area represents pupils projected from county live birth statistics. The clear portion represents pupils who are already enrolled in your school district. The enrollment projections do not account for closing or opening of a private or chartered school, consolidation, annexation, or re-zoning of your district in the future. Such out-of-the-ordinary occurrences must be accounted for separately.

**Grade Pattern:** The second page of the enrollment projection report sums up (compiles) pupil enrollment by grades into groups that corresponding with your school district's grade pattern or building configuration. It is a tool to identify potential facility utilization, for considering future grade pattern changes, and for planning of future school facilities, etc.
